RULES FOR FOUR-PART CANDIDATES

- A candidate must register and schedule all four parts of the course upon initial registration and complete all four parts of the course within a 12-month period.
- A candidate enrolled in all four parts may change the sequence or delivery method at any time within the original 12-month period. The new sequence must fall within the original 12-month period. If the change falls outside of the original 12 month period, the candidate will be required to re-enroll as a former candidate and, as such, charged 50% tuition plus a registration fee for those parts. A \$195 administrative change fee will be charged to the student beginning with the 2nd change and will apply to all subsequent changes. Please review additional requirements for changes by following the refund/ cancellation policies below for the format you are enrolled.

RULES FOR INDIVIDUAL-PART CANDIDATES

- Within the 12 month period from initial registration, a candidate may change the course format, delivery method or sequence of their CPA Exam Review parts. No charge will apply for the first change; however, an administrative fee will apply to all subsequent changes. Please review additional requirements for changes by following the refund/ cancellation policies below for the format you are enrolled.
- A candidate enrolled in individual parts, starting one or more of the parts past the 12-month period, will be required to re-enroll as a former candidate and, as such, charged 50% tuition plus a registration fee for those parts. IN CLASS CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:

For Individual Part Candidates: A full tuition refund (minus all applicable savings and fees) will be issued prior to the day of the second class, thereafter candidates are entitled to a prorated refund (minus all applicable savings and fees) for the unused portion through 60% of the part taken.

For 4-Part Candidates: A full tuition refund (minus all applicable savings and fees) will be issued prior to the day of the second class, thereafter candidates are entitled to a prorated refund (minus all applicable savings and fees) for the unused portion through 60% of the entire course.

To cancel this agreement and receive a refund, provide a written notice by certified mail, overnight mail, or other form assuring proof of receipt to the Candidate Services Manager at One Tower Lane, Suite 1000, Oakbrook Terrace, IL 60181. The refund will be made within 30 days following receipt of cancellation notice. No refund will be given if notice of cancellation is received after attending F-5, R-4, A-3 and B-3.
